### **Role of Homecoming Court**

The members of the Homecoming Court hold very prestigious positions. As ambassadors and stewards of Georgia State University, the Homecoming Court will represent the University at a variety of events such as the Press Conference, Good Morning Georgia State, Spirit Plaza, Royal Ball, Block Party, Golf Cart Parade, and the Homecoming Game. All other potential events will be discussed during the informational meeting on each campus.

Royal court candidates should be well-rounded, must exhibit leadership skills, and will possess the ability to work well within a team setting. Candidates should be influential in their involvement throughout their organizations and the University. As an elected representative of the University, the position of Homecoming Royal Court member comes with much esteem and responsibility. We expect all Royal Court representatives to be a positive voice and professional representative for the University.

#### **Campaigning & Voting**

Perimeter Campus – Campus representatives (Imperial Court) – Campaigning begins on Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. **Voting** is Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>.

Atlanta Campus & Perimeter Campus – Royal Court campaigning begins on Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. Voting begins on Monday, October 17<sup>th</sup> and ends on Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup> at noon. Voting will take place online at Homecoming.gsu.edu.

### Court Eligibility and General Information

- Must be enrolled for the entire 2016-2017 Academic School Year,
- Must have met classification by the end of the Summer 2016 semester,
- Must be able to attend ALL Homecoming events the week of October 11 -October 22, 2016,
- Must be in good academic and judicial standing with the university,
- You may not ask Spotlight Programs Board, Panther Activities Council, Student Government Association or any department, faculty, or staff member to endorse you during the Royal Court process,
- Eligible students may run independently or under the endorsement and/or sponsorship of a student organization. Students are not required to be a member of the organization in order to receive an endorsement/sponsorship,
- The Homecoming Court will consist of 18 candidates,
  - o 3 candidates for Ms. Georgia State / 3 candidates for Mr. Georgia State
  - o 3 candidates for Ms. Blue & White/ 3 candidates for Mr. Blue & White
  - o 3 candidates for Ms. Perimeter/ 3 candidates for Mr. Perimeter
- The 2016-2017 Homecoming Court will be announced during halftime of the Homecoming Football Game on October 22, 2016,
- Judges will consist of GSU faculty, staff, Traditions Chair, Royal Court Chairs, and/or Alumni.
- Students who are stipended officers of SGA, Panther Activities Council and Spotlight Programs Board or who serve on the Spirit & Traditions Committee of Spotlight Programs Board or the Traditions committee of Panther Activities Council are not eligible to apply to serve on the Homecoming Royal Court. Students who serve on Royal Court are eligible to apply for stipended positions with SGA, Panther Activities Council and Spotlight Programs Board after the crowning of the Royal Court.
